Refunds/Cancellations:

*All fees are non-refundable unless the class is cancelled.

*Refunds for cancelled workshops will be processed within 3 weeks after cancellation notice.

Punctuality:

*Parents/guardians must come into the camp location to sign their child/children in and out each day of camp.

*Participants should arrive **no more than 10 minutes prior** to the start time of each activity, and should be picked up **no later than 10 minutes after** the activity is scheduled to end.

Transportation:

*When transportation is provided to another location for a program, participants who arrive **more than 5 minutes late will be left and no refund will be given.**

*Because of car seat laws, transportation for **5-7 year old** will not be provided by 4-H.

SETTING UP A PROFILE

You will be required to set up a family profile on **4HOnline**, the on-line North Carolina 4-H Enrollment and event registration program. The family profile will be where the members (Youth & Adults) will enroll. The website can be found at <https://nc.4honline.com>

1 If you need to create a family profile, select "I need to setup a profile," complete the fields required and click Create Login.

What happens if it says **User account already exists**? This means a family profile exists with that email address because your child was already enrolled through their local Extension Office. Select "I forgot my password" and a new password will be emailed to the email address on file. **Please do not create a 2nd account!** Then follow the steps on the tip-sheet, **Re-Enrolling in 4hOnline**.

2 Follow the instructions on the Family Information page and click *Continue*.
SET UP ONLY ONE (1) FAMILY PROFILE PER HOUSEHOLD!

After adding the family, add your family members to that family profile. Use the follow to determine the type of membership to add:

- **Adult:** 4-H volunteers
- **Youth:** 4-H youth between the ages of 8 and 19 who are involved in a 4-H program

IMPORTANT! Adult records should only belong to adult volunteers.

For adults and youth, the next pages are authorization releases and health forms for risk management. These are important to have completed in case you get injured at a club meeting or 4-H event. If you have questions or concerns when filling out the forms, contact your **County Extension Office**.

When adding a club, select the club from the drop down and click "Add Club" button to save the selected club. Repeat the same steps to choose your project(s). Each 4-H youth member must have at least one club to be marked active and valid.

Note: *Members at Large* (Youth members who do not belong to a club) should select the "Member at Large" club option.

Adult Volunteers: If you are a club volunteer - select your club from the drop-down bar. If you are **not** a club volunteer - skip this section - by clicking *Continue*.

UPDATING UP A 4HONLINE PROFILE

4-H requires annual updates of membership information within our 4HOnline program. 4HOnline is the on-line North Carolina 4-H Enrollment and event registration program. *If you have an existing Family Profile please take a few minutes and make any necessary updates (new address, changes in clubs, medical information, etc.) during the re-enrollment period which begins each year on January 1st. The website can be found at <https://nc.4honline.com>

Who Needs to Re-Enroll

Effective January 1, 2019, only youth members and 4-H volunteers who are enrolled in 4HOnline will be considered active members and / or active 4-H volunteers.

How to Re-Enroll

- 4-H members and volunteers must enroll in 4-H annually.
- On or after Jan. 1 of the current year, go to the 4HOnline login screen at <https://nc.4honline.com> *4-H enrollment is ongoing throughout the calendar year.
- Login to your family account.
- Review and update the information for each youth member and / or yourself.
 - Click on the "Edit Tab" to access the youth / volunteers personal information and click Enroll for current 4-H year.
 - Continue through profile and make any necessary changes.
 - Health Information and 4-H Authorizations (Photo Release, Volunteer Screening, etc.) must be updated annually.
 - If you need to add/delete a club do so at this time.
 - Youth members must enroll in a 4-H Club (members can select multiple clubs) - and - youth members will need to designate at least 1 project they plan to participate in during the year (previous projects remain in the members enrollment history).
- When you've made all the necessary updates - Click "submit enrollment."

Once your enrollment has been submitted, it is sent to the local Extension Office to be approved. You should get a message back indicating your enrollment has been submitted. If there are any problems with your enrollment - you will get an e-mail with instructions for logging back in (with the same email / password you set up) and correcting those. If there are no problems, you will receive an e-mail stating that you have been accepted and will have access on-line to your enrollment to make any updates throughout the year, to register for events, etc.






We encourage you to keep your login (family e-mail address and password) written down in a secure location so, that you can access your profile at your leisure.








Note: If you've forgotten your password - you will need to click on "I forgot my password" and follow the instructions. *If you know you have an account but can't remember the Email address you used to set up your account you'll need to contact your 4-H agent - they can provide you that information.








